Soul Alignment: Writing True to Self and Authentically to Readers

In this short, hands-on session, we start by choosing a single focus that feels true to who we are. Think of it as finding the heartbeat of your piece. Once that center is clear, we'll guide it into a draft that is readable, publishable, and deeply ours.



You will work with a simple framework that turns spark into structure. We'll cover how to open with clarity, how to shape a middle that keeps readers with you, and how to land the ending so it feels satisfying. Expect quick prompts, a little quiet time to write, and supportive feedback that helps you polish without losing your voice.

You will leave with a solid start, a checklist for revisions, and a plan for where to place your work. Bring a notebook or laptop, a curious mind, and one idea that will not let you go.

December Meeting Recap: Polish Your Pitch with Bob Baker


